PHARMACY PRACTICE RESIDENCY

The Pharmacy Department provides service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and is decentralized to five satellites. Specialized pharmaceutical services are provided throughout the hospital, including:

The role of pharmacy in patient care is widely accepted. At RWJUH, the pharmacists serve as active participants in the interdisciplinary healthcare team.

The Pharmacy Practice Residency at RWJUH is an ASHP-accredited program that uses the Residency Learning System, a tool designed to guide the resident through designated objectives. Rotation schedules are flexible, allowing the individual to tailor the program to one's areas of interest.

Opportunities are available to develop teaching skills by providing didactic and experiential education for Rutgers pharmacy students. The resident will acquire a broad range of clinical, distributive, management, and teaching skills. Completion of a research project to be presented at the Eastern States Residency Conference is required. Upon completion of the residency, the resident will be equipped with the working skills to assume a leadership role in pharmacy practice.

The City of New Brunswick has a population of over 40,000 and is located in central New Jersey. It is the home of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, as well as the international headquarters of the Johnson and Johnson family of companies. New Brunswick has a newly renovated downtown area and is about 50 miles from both New York City and Philadelphia.

The goal of the residency at RWJUH is to develop the resident's independent practice skills and confidence in a variety of general practice and specialty areas.
