

ADMISSION TO the Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy is highly competitive. Our doctor of pharmacy (PharmD) program begins with two years of preprofessional study and proceeds to four years of professional pharmacy school. Because ours is one of the few 0–6 pharmacy programs, students may apply for entry to the preprofessional phase directly from high school or transfer into the professional school from a two- or four-year college or from another school at Rutgers. Those holding a bachelor’s or advanced degree may also apply to the PharmD program.

COST AND VALUE

As a public University, Rutgers delivers a quality education at a cost significantly below those of its private-school peers. The 2024-2025 estimated costs are listed below.

Note that the university classifies students as undergraduates for the first four years of the pharmacy program and as graduate students for the final two years; this classification is reflected in the differing costs for room and board in years 1 through 4 and years 5 and 6 of the six-year pharmacy program. The cost of room and board will vary with the type of accommodation and meal plan selected. You should also budget for books, transportation, and personal expenses.
