

**Directions to Parking Lot 58**  
**Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy**

**From New Jersey Turnpike (North or South)**

- Turn off at Exit 9; after toll booths bear to the right; follow signs for “Route 18 North- New Brunswick”
- Continue along Route 18 North past the exits for “Route 27 and “Rutgers University” and proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge (Approx. 4.2 miles)
- Follow directions to campus from Route 18 below

**From Garden State Parkway (North of South)**  
**Southbound – Coming from Northern New Jersey**

- Turn off at Exit 129 for the New Jersey Turnpike and head south
- Continue along Route 18 North past the exits for “Route 27” and “Rutgers University” and processed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge (Approx. 4.2 miles)
- Follow directions to campus from Route 18 below

**Northbound – Coming from Southern New Jersey**

- Turn off at Exit 105 and follow signs for Route 18 North
- After approximately 24 miles you will pass the entrance for the New Jersey Turnpike and continue on Route 18 North
- Continue along Route 18 North past the exits for “Route 27” and “Rutgers University” and proceed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge (Approx. 4.2 miles)
- Follow directions to campus from Route 18 below

**From Route 1 (North of South)**

- Turn off at exit marked “Route 18 North- New Brunswick
- Continue along Route 18 North past exits for “Route 27” and “Rutgers University” and processed over the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge (Approx. 4.2 miles)
- Follow directions to campus from Route 18 below

**From Route 18**

- Turn off exit marked “Campus Road – Rutgers Stadium- Busch Campus”
- Continue on Campus Road to the roundabout and bear to the right
- Take the second right onto Frelinghuysen Road
- Make a right onto Allison Road
- Go down Allison Road to stop sign and make left onto Bevier Road and you will see Lot 58 on the left (Library of Science and Medicine lot)

From parking lots you will see William Levine Hall/Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy building.
