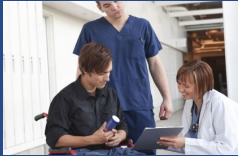


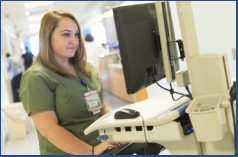

Services provided

The Department of Pharmacy Services is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Pharmacists work directly with physicians, nurses, and allied health personnel, in a central pharmacy distributive model with automated dispensing cabinets and decentralized clinical services. Pharmacy Clinical Specialists, including two Rutgers Faculty members, are deployed by nursing units or service, including two medical/surgical units, Hospitalist service, critical care, emergency medicine, psychiatry, infectious diseases service, and ambulatory care clinic.

Jersey City Medical Center has two PGY-1 Pharmacy Residency Residents. Jersey City Medical Center is an academic teaching and practice site for Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy, Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey.
