Application Submission: You may apply online at **Graduate and Professional Admissions**

Application Deadlines:

Completed applications should be received prior to:

- **March 1** for Fall Admission
- **November 1** for Spring Admission

Admission Document Requirements:

The application is viewed as complete when it contains the following documents:

1. **Proof of English Proficiency:** We accept IELTS, TOEFL, and Duolingo. Our graduate program follows Rutgers University's minimum acceptable score for each test. If you attended a university where instruction was in English, you may submit a letter confirming this.
2. **Minimum 2 letters of recommendation:** The letters must come from people who can best evaluate your potential for high-level research and advanced academic study. The most valuable letters come from professors and supervisors who know you well and can provide specific examples of your skills, rather than individuals with prestigious titles who barely know you.
3. **Personal Statement:** one-page maximum.
4. **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** The applicants must mention the following statement at the bottom of their CVs and sign:

"I certify that the statements made by me in this Curriculum Vitae are true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that any willful misstatement or omission may lead to the disqualification of my application or termination of enrollment".

5. Transcript Evaluation: For International students only

6. Official GRE Scores:

Quantitative Reasoning score: **Recommended**. Although it is not mandatory, a strong quantitative reasoning score may positively impact on admission review.

Verbal Reasoning score: **optional**. No impact on admission.

Analytical Reasoning score: **optional**. No impact on admission.

Admission Fee Waivers

Graduate Admissions Application Fee Waivers: The Office of Graduate Admissions grants application fee waivers to the following groups only: active U.S. military and military veterans who plan to apply for educational benefits under the GI Bill; current Rutgers students and alumni; and participants in various scholar programs. Students are automatically reviewed for fee waiver eligibility based on the information they provide on their Rutgers graduate school application.
