Facilities and resources

Laboratories

The majority of the laboratories and offices of the faculty in the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Science are housed on the Busch Campus in the Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy and the adjacent Laboratory for Cancer Research (LCR). Other facilities are also located on the Busch Campus in the Chemistry Building, Chemical & Biomedical Engineering, Environmental & Occupation Health Sciences Institute (EOHSI), and by the Livingston Campus at the Gordon Road Facility. These laboratories are well-equipped for cutting-edge cellular/molecular metabolism disposition. research in biology, and drug transport, drug delivery, pharmacogenetics, pharmacogenomics pharmacology, signal transduction, chemistry, and in vivo animal studies.

Clinical

Many collaborative projects are ongoing with our clinical faculty in the Department of Pharmacy Practice and Administration in the Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy and Robert Johnson Medical School (RWJ) at several adjacent hospitals including Robert Wood Johnson, and St. Peters Hospitals in New Brunswick, RWJ Somerset, St. Barnabas Hospital Livingston, and other RWJBarnabas Health System.
